For 24 hours after the sedation you must not:

- drive a car
- operate machinery
- drink alcohol
- sign legally binding documents

Please ensure you have a responsible adult with you for the next 24 hours.

At the discretion of the nursing staff you may drive home 30 minutes after using Entonox.

You can eat and drink as normal from _____ starting with sips of water. Your throat may be uncomfortable for 24 hours.

If you experience severe pain or discomfort in your neck, chest or abdomen you must contact one of the telephone numbers listed on the following pages.

You may experience wind type pains, but this should settle when you start moving around.

If you have had a polypectomy please:

- be aware that you may notice blood in the toilet or on the paper
- watch for increased pain in your abdomen
- watch for any raised temperature

If your pain becomes worse, you experience any heavy bleeding, are passing blood clots or if you experience severe pain or distention in your lower abdomen, you must contact one of the telephone numbers on the following page.

It may take 2 – 3 days for your bowel movements to return to normal.

Follow up:

If you have had any samples taken today your consultant will let you know the results within 6-8 weeks, or contact your GP.

If you have been diagnosed as having a **Gastric Ulcer, Barrett's Oesophagus or Oesophagitis** and you require a repeat gastroscopy, please do not stop your acid suppressing medication e.g. Lansoprazole or Omeprazole until after you have had your repeat procedure. You may need to see your G.P for a repeat prescription.
