Efudix cream instructions

Apply accurately twice daily for 2 weeks then take 1 week off.

Wash fingers after use and do not apply near the eyes.

Repeat this 2 week on / 1 week off cycle for any remaining scaling / thickening.

The cycle can be repeated several times.

If any burning develops, at the first sign of this take the 1 week off immediately rather than continuing for the full 2 weeks.
